Otoplasty Instructions

- 1. Dressing is worn first night of surgery and will be removed the day following surgery by our staff.
- 2. Following this, a ski-cap type hat or headband should be worn for the next two weeks to protect the ears while sleeping.
- Sleep on your back for six weeks.
- 4. Do not wear pullover clothing for ten days following surgery. Use button-down shirts only.
- 5. Clean the incision behind the ear every two hours, which should be six times a day, with Hydrogen Peroxide, and then follow this with Polysporin ointment applied on a Q-tip to the incision.
- 6. Do not pull the ears under any circumstances.
- 7. You may shower on the day following surgery; however, keep the ear dry and do not wipe or pull at the ears.
- 8. If there is any redness, swelling, increased pain, or drainage, please contact the office immediately.
